**Henstilling om styrevedtak om akademisk boikott av Israel**

Vi er 537 ansatte og studenter ved Universitetet i Oslo om har signert det nylige [oppropet for akademisk boikott av Israel](#), som også er blitt omtalt i [Uniforum](#) og [Forskerforum](#). I skrivende stund har oppropet 537 signaturer fra ansatte og studenter ved Universitetet i Oslo.

Undertegnede vil, med de grunner angitt i oppropet, **henstille til styret om å vedta at Universitetet i Oslo støtter akademisk boikott av Israel.**

**Dette er kravene til UiO som de 537 ansatte og studenter stiller seg bak:**

1. at UiO erkjenner at israelske universitet er store, villige og konstante medløperer for det israelske okkupasjonsregimet, bosetterkolonialismen og apartheid. De er med på å utvikle våpensystem og militære doktriner som blir brukt i Gaza.
2. at UiO bryter alt institusjonelt samarbeid med høyere utdanningsinstitusjoner i Israel og nekter å delta i akademiske møter som er finansiert eller organisert av israelske institusjoner.
3. at UiO avslutter alle innkjøpsavtaler med leverandører som har tilknytning til det israelske militæret eller som er aktive i de ulovlige bosetningene og i okkuperte palestinske områder, som for eksempel Hewlett Packard og Dell.
4. at UiO tar en klar stilling og kommer med en offentlig kunngjøring der det fordømmer de israelske massedrapene og volden, bosetterkolonialismen, okkupasjonen og apartheid-loven mot det palestinske folket, og ber om en øyeblikkelig og permanent våpenhvile, anerkjennelse av en palestinsk stat og retten palestinerne har til å styre seg selv.
5. at UiO skal jobbe for å presse den norske regjeringen til å sanksjonere den israelske regjeringen, inkludert kravet om at Oljefondet skal trekke investeringene sine ut av alle israelske selskap og internasjonale selskap som er med på å opprettholde israelsk apartheid inkludert de selskapene som er virksomme i de ulovlige bosetningene i Palestina.

Som det redegjøres for i oppropet, er det godt dokumentert at israelske høyere utdanningsinstitusjoner bidrar til undertrykkelsen av våre palestinske kolleger.

Israelske høyre utdanningsinstitusjoner er sammenvevd med det israelske militæret, og har bidratt til utvikling av våpen, teknologi og politisk teori som brukes i den vedvarende okkupasjon av Palestina og apartheid-regimet, og til å legitimere krigføringen mot et okkupert folk. I tillegg har israelske universiteter infrastruktur på okkuperte områder. Ingen israelske universiteter har heller ikke offentlig fordømt de systematiske overgrepene mot den palestinske høyere utdanningssektoren som er under angrep akkurat nå.

Akademikere ved Universitetet i Oslo bør ikke samarbeide med israelske institusjoner som aktivt støtter opp om okkupasjon, apartheid, og krigsforbrytelser, og som er med på å frarøve våre palestinske kollegaer sin akademiske frihet.

All empiri demonstrerer tydelig at 76 år med politisk og akademisk dialog ikke har forbedret situasjonen for våre palestinske kolleger, og at sterkere virkemidler derfor er påkrevd. I Gaza er mange hundre studenter og ansatte blitt bombet til døde og samtlige universiteter er ødelagt av bomber. Blant de drepte palestinske akademikere er rektoren og to forskere ved University College of Applied Sciences i Gaza som Universitetet i Oslo har et aktivt samarbeidsprosjekt med (E-Pal). På Vestbredden har ansatte og studenter i UH-sektoren blitt rutinemessig arrestert av israelske okkupasjonsstyrker i mange tiår. De holdes ofte i israelsk fangenskap uten siktelse eller domfellelse, og som Amnesty International og andre menneskerettsorganisasjoner har dokumentert i en årrekke blir fangene utsatt for tortur. Ansatte og studenter blir rutinemessig forhindret i å nå lærestedene av israelske militærsperringer og universiteter blir jevnlig invadert av israelske okkupasjonsstyrker. Dette skjedde senest den 8. november ved Birzeit University og den 16. november ved Palestine Technical University i Tulkarem. Israelske militærlover detaljstyrer hvilke utenlandske akademikere som får lov til å undervise ved palestinske universiteter. Den palestinske UH-sektoren har aldri operert i fravær av okkupasjon.

Israelske universiteter gir heller ikke sine egne ansatte og studenter full akademisk frihet. Et nylig eksempel er Hebrew University sitt forsøk på å avskjedige Dr. Nadera Shalhoub- Kevorkian etter at hun signerte et opprop for våpenhvile i Gaza. Siden 7. oktober har 115 palestinske studenter blitt utsatt for formelle sanksjoner fra 33 ulike israelske høyere utdanningsinstitusjoner, i de fleste tilfeller for å uttrykke kritikk av Israels krigføring i Gaza.

Universiteter har kjerneprinsipper som handler om sannhetssøken, humanisme, demokrati, etikk og respekt for internasjonalt lovverk. Disse prinsippene er truet av den israelske regjeringen og mange akademiske institusjonene som støtter regjeringens politikk. Det er nettopp derfor vi mener at UiO må bruke sin institusjonelle autonomi og revidere sine etiske retningslinjer for å støtte akademisk boikott av Israel. Vi mener at UiOs nåværende retningslinjer om å være imot akademisk boikott er i konflikt med retningslinjene om å fremheve grunnleggende menneskerettigheter. Vi mener at UiO ikke ha gjort en tilstrekkelig gjennomgang av den manglende akademiske friheten og menneskerettsbruddene ved de israelske institusjonene som UiO har nåværende samarbeidsavtaler med (jmfør UiOs etiske retningslinjer).

Vi presiserer at akademisk boikott av Israel ikke omfatter boikott av enkeltindivider i israelsk academia (bortsatt fra de med formelle representasjonsroller). Vi avviser alle

former for boikott av enkeltindivider basert på deres identitet eller institusjonelle tilhørighet.

Med dette som grunnlag (i tillegg til det som står i det originale oppropet vedlagt) ber vi om at **Universitetsstyret ved Universitetet i Oslo vedtar å unngå alt fremtidig institusjonelt samarbeid med israelske universiteter og høyskoler, samt vedtar å unngå innkjøpsavtaler med leverandører som har forbindelser med det israelske militæret eller operer i de okkuperte palestinske områdene.**

**Vi forventer en respons innen mandag 22. januar fra rektor Svein Stølen og universitetsstyret og at kravene som stilles i oppropet blir tatt opp som vedtakssak i det neste universitetsstyremøtet på tirsdag 6. februar 2024.**

# Call for an Academic Boycott of Israel at the University of Oslo

21st December 2023

Dear Rector Svein Stølen & the University of Oslo Board,

We, students and staff at the University of Oslo, extend our solidarity to the Palestinian people and call for the University of Oslo to immediately implement an academic boycott of Israel. We build upon the [call for an academic boycott of Israel signed by 315 academics across Norway](#), and direct this letter towards our home institution, the University of Oslo.

We are witnessing ongoing genocidal violence that is perpetrated by the Israeli state against Palestinians living in Gaza and the West Bank. [As of 20th December 2023, more than 20,000 Palestinians in Gaza have been killed](#), and [more than 8,000 Palestinians are still missing under the rubble. In the West Bank, 301 Palestinians have been killed by the IOF](#). In addition, we are witnessing devastating damages and destruction to infrastructure, including residential houses, places of worship, hospitals, bakeries, ambulances as well as educational facilities by the Israeli military.

We are horrified by the near total destruction of the higher educational sector in Gaza. [Over 70% of educational structures have been destroyed by mid-December \(352 buildings\)](#). Furthermore, it is reported that the [al-Azhar University, the North Gaza and Tubas branches of Al-Quds Open University, and the Islamic University, to name a few, have been completely or partially destroyed](#). We are devastated by the killing of hundreds of our fellow university staff and students, including [Mohammed Hassouna who was connected to the UiO-based E-Pal Project \(NORHEDII\)](#). Tens of thousands of university students are unable to access education. We heed [the call of our colleagues from Birzeit University](#) to speak up against genocidal violence, occupation, and the flagrant violation of human rights in Gaza and Palestine and call for the academic community to fulfil its mission of critique towards oppressive structures, of warning against the rippling effects of violence and occupation, and of speaking truth to power.

This latest siege comes as a continuation and escalation of the daily violence and ethnic cleansing Palestinians have faced for over 75 years from Israeli settler colonization; an [apartheid regime](#) whose occupation is in clear violation of international law but persists with the financial, military and moral support of powerful governments globally. This is an act of collective punishment, in contravention of international law, which threatens the lives of over two million people, half of whom are children, with unimaginable violence and displacement.

We are highly critical of the double standards the University of Oslo who unequivocally [condemned the Russian invasion of Ukraine](#), however [failed to explicitly condemn the genocidal violence of Israel against Palestinians and the ongoing occupation and apartheid regime in Palestine](#). Whilst we support the Norwegian government's calls for a permanent ceasefire, we oppose [Norwegian companies' supply of arms both directly and indirectly to the Israeli military \(such as the M14 rocket launchers from Nammo\)](#). Moreover, the [Government Pension Fund of Norway \(Oljefondet\)](#) still has more than 140 billion Norwegian kroner invested in at least 66

[companies operating in illegal settlements in the West Bank](#). We support the divestment from companies that sustain Israeli apartheid and demands for an arms embargo on the Israeli state. More pressure and sanctions must be placed on Israel to stop the unfathomable violence and to end the occupation.

We join people around the world who are raising their voices in protest of this assault on human life. As students and educators, it is our duty to stand by the principles of critical inquiry and learning, to hold the university as a space for conversation that foregrounds historical truths, and that contextualizes this past two months and more of violence in the context of 75 years of settler colonial occupation and Western imperialism. We cannot sit back and witness the continuation of this [genocide](#).

**We demand that our home institution and the biggest university in Norway, University of Oslo, does the following:**

- 1) Recognises that Israeli universities are [major, willing, and persistent accomplices](#) in Israel's regime of occupation, settler-colonialism, and apartheid. They are involved in [developing weapon systems and military doctrines](#) deployed in Israeli violence in Gaza.
- 2) Cuts all institutional cooperating with Israeli higher educational institutions and refuses to partake in academic events sponsored or organised by Israeli institutions.
- 3) Cancels all purchasing agreements with suppliers that have [connections with the Israeli military or that operate in illegal settlements and Palestinian occupied territories, including Hewlett Packard](#) and [Dell](#).
- 4) Takes a clear stance and makes a clear public statement condemning the Israeli genocidal violence, settler colonialism, occupation, and apartheid of the Palestinian people, and calling for an immediate and permanent ceasefire, recognition of the state of Palestine and right of Palestinians to self-determination.
- 5) Dedicatedly works to apply all forms of pressure on the Norwegian government to sanction the Israeli government, including demanding that Oljefondet divest from all Israeli companies and international companies that sustain Israeli apartheid including those operating in illegal settlements in Palestine.
